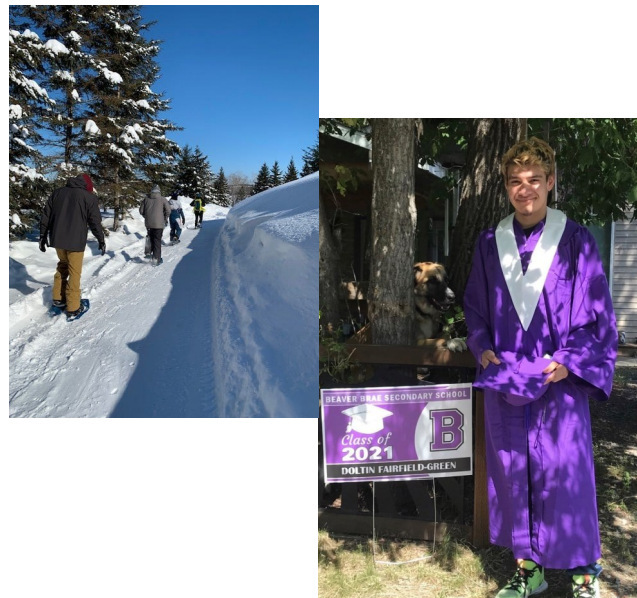
Cultural Learning Component
